#### ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini membahas tentang tahap-tahap perjalanan seorang pahlawan. Dalam penelitian ini penulis menganalisa novel Oliver Twist karya Charles Dickens yang diterbitkan pada tahun 1839. Dalam hal ini penulis menganalisa pola-pola kepahlawanan yang dilalui oleh Oliver Twist sebagai karakter utama. Perjalanan yang dilakukan bertujuan untuk mencari identitas dirinya, kebebasan hidupnya dan tempat yang layak untuknya dan London adalah tempat yang ingin ditujunya.

Penelitian ini bersifat kualitatif dengan menggunakan metode deskriptif. Data yang diperlukan diperoleh dari penelitian kepustakaan dan beberapa sumber lain yang berhubungan dengan penelitian ini. Data utama penulis berasal dari novel itu sendiri dan data sekunder berasal dari buku-buku yang berhubungan dengan topik yang dibahas penulis dan juga dari internet. Untuk menganalisa pola-pola kepahlwanan tersebut, penulis menggunakan teori yang dikemukakan oleh Joseph Campbell dimana seorang pahlawan itu harus melalui tiga tahap untuk mendapatkan tujuannya dan menjadikannya seorang pahlawan. Tahap-tahap itu adalah Keberangkatan, Permulaan dan Kedatangan kembali (The Departure, Initiation and Return.)

Dari hasil analisa ini, penulis menyimpulkan bahwa Oliver telah melakukan perjalanan ke London dan dia bisa dikatakan sebagai seorang pahlawan karena dia telah melewati ketiga tahap kepahlawanan, yaitu The Departure, Initiation and Return. Tiap tahap kepahlawanan mempunyai fase-fase tertentu yang harus dilalui oleh Oliver. Oliver menjadi lebih baik setelah melakukan perjalanan ini, dia bisa berfikir lebih dewasa dalam memecahkan suatu masalah.

Here, the writer is interested in analyzing Oliver Twist written by Charles Dickens. This novel presents the reader with the patterns of the hero's journey.

There are so many researches and reviews about Oliver Twist written by Charles Dickens such as Beberapa Catatan Tentang Oliver Twist Karya Charles Dickens by Indra Topan (1987), Childhood Disharmony of Oliver Twist As The Impact Of Social Discrepancy During Industrial Revolution. A Novel By Charles Dickens by Evelyn Diana Putri (1997), and Little Orphan Oliver by Peter Reeve (2005). Generally these researches focus on the language and the intrinsic elements such as theme, characters, and messages. They never talk about hero journey in detail Based on the writer's observation, there is no one who studies this novel by using archetypal approach, since Oliver Twist reflects a journey that has been experienced by the main character, Oliver Twist. Therefore, the writer is challenged to analyze this novel by using archetypal approach and theory from Joseph Campbell about the hero's journey.

There is another reason that make the writer decide to choose this novel as her research analysis, that is <u>Oliver Twist</u> is an interesting novel since the main character is a nine years old boy that described as a hero. Based on Joseph Campbell, hero

means the person who has passed the tree stages of hero's journey. Oliver can be said as a hero because he has passed the stages of hero's journey based on Joseph Campbell theory. The main character makes this novel different from the other novels because in this novel the writer finds the hero is a child meanwhile the hero is mostly identical with a strong man and hard to defeat. Therefore, from the above reasons, the writer entitles this analysis, "The Hero Journey In Charles Dickens' Oliver Twist"
